

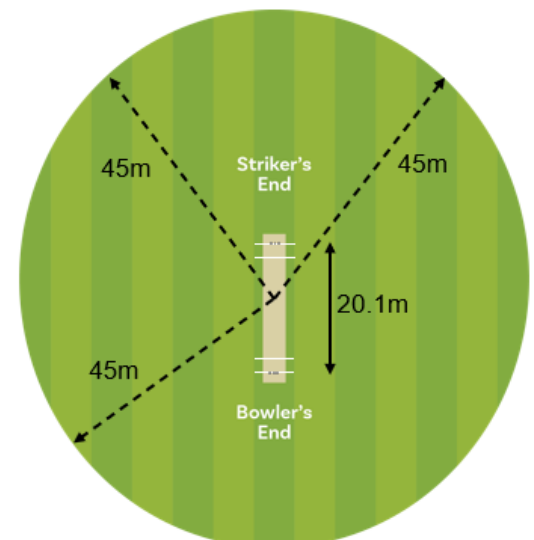

<b>BOUNDARY</b>	45 METRE BOUNDARY MEASURED FROM THE CENTRE OF THE PITCH	
<b>PITCH LENGTH</b>	20.1 METRE PITCH, STUMP TO STUMP – HARD WICKET. 1 x SET OF PORTABLE SPRING-BACK STUMPS ARE REQUIRED	
<b>TEAM NUMBERS</b>	7 MINIMUM, 11 MAXIMUM PER TEAM (9 PLAYERS RECOMMENDED) MAXIMUM 9 PLAYERS ON FIELD	
<b>UNLIMITED DISMISSALS</b>	NO	
<b>DISMISSALS</b>	ALL MODES OF DISMISSAL COUNT, A BATTER MUST BE GIVEN A WARNING BEFORE BEING GIVEN OUT LBW	
<b>BATTING</b>	BALLS FACED INCLUDES WIDES & NO BALLS. BATTERS MUST WEAR A HELMET AT ALL TIMES.	
<b>BOWLING</b>	5 OVERS BOWLED FROM ONE END. 6 BALLS PER OVER, EXCEPT THE FINAL OVER WHERE 6 LEGAL DELIVERIES MUST BE BOWLED.	
<b>WIDES / NO BALLS</b>	1-RUN PENALTY, RE-BOWLED (MAXIMUM OF 8 BALLS PER OVER, EXCEPT THE FINAL OVER).	
<b>WIDE</b>	ONLY IF THE BALL BOWLED DEVIATES OUTSIDE THE MARKED PITCH PRIOR TO THE BATTING CREASE	
<b>NO BALL</b>	FULL TOSS ABOVE WAIST HEIGHT, BALL BOUNCING ABOVE SHOULDER HEIGHT, BALL BOUNCING MORE THAN ONCE BEFORE BATTING CREASE, BOUNCING WHOLLY OFF PITCH (ALL CAN BE HIT BY THE BATTER)	
<b>NO BALL, DEAD BALL (SAFETY)</b>	ANY BALL PLAYED BY A BATTER COMPLETELY OFF THE PITCH, OR STOPS BEFORE THE BATTING CREASE	
<b>FIELDING</b>	NO FIELDERS WITHIN 15 METRES OF BATTER (EXCL. WICKET-KEEPER, SLIPS AND GULLY). EACH TEAM HAS THE OPTION TO USE 2 WICKET-KEEPERS, WHO MUST WEAR A HELMET AT ALL TIMES. FIELDERS TO ROTATE AND	
<b>FREE HIT</b>	NO, BOTH TEAMS BAT THE FULL INNINGS

## ADVERSE WEATHER POLICY

### HOT WEATHER - CANCELLATION IN ADVANCE

LOCATIONS FOR TEMPERATURE READINGS ARE AS FOLLOWS;  
WESTERN SUBURBS CRICKET ASSOCIATION – ADELAIDE AIRPORT

### FRIDAY AFTERNOON MATCHES

THE FINAL DECISION ON WHETHER FRIDAY AFTERNOON MATCHES ARE PLAYED WILL BE MADE FOLLOWING THE UPDATED BOM FORECAST RELEASED ON THURSDAY EVENING AT 6:00PM. SHOULD THE FORECAST TEMPERATURE FOR 5:30PM FRIDAY ON THE BOM APP, AS AT 6:00PM ON THURSDAY EVENING BE 36 DEGREES CELSIUS OR ABOVE, ALL MATCHES WILL BE CANCELLED.

### SATURDAY MORNING MATCHES

THE FINAL DECISION ON WHETHER SATURDAY MORNING MATCHES ARE PLAYED WILL BE MADE FOLLOWING THE UPDATED BOM FORECAST RELEASED ON FRIDAY EVENING AT 6:00PM. SHOULD THE FORECAST TEMPERATURE FOR 12:30PM ON SATURDAY ON THE BOM APP, AS AT 6:00PM ON FRIDAY EVENING BE 38 DEGREES CELSIUS OR ABOVE, ALL MATCHES WILL BE CANCELLED.

### IF THE FORECAST FALLS BELOW THE THRESHOLD TO CANCEL MATCHES:

IN ALL REMAINING SITUATIONS, PLAY WILL OCCUR AND SHALL CONTINUE UNTIL THE WEATHER REACHES 36 DEGREES CELSIUS **AT THE VENUE OF THE MATCH** ON FRIDAY, OR 38 DEGREES CELSIUS **AT THE VENUE OF THE MATCH** ON SATURDAY (AS PER THE BOM APP). SHOULD THE TEMPERATURE THRESHOLD BE REACHED DURING THE DAY AND PLAY BE CANCELLED, THAT SHALL BE THE FINAL OUTCOME FOR THE DAY AND PLAY SHALL NOT RESUME.

### WET WEATHER

IN THE EVENT OF EXTREME WET WEATHER CONDITIONS LEADING UP TO A ROUND OF MATCHES, THE ASSOCIATION MAY CANCEL MATCHES IN A ROUND OF CRICKET. WHERE THE ASSOCIATION HAS NOT CANCELLED A ROUND OF MATCHES, THE HOME CLUB WILL ADVISE THE OPPOSITION BY **6:00PM ON THE DAY PRIOR TO THE MATCH**, IF THE GROUND IS UNSUITABLE FOR PLAY.

**NOTE:** IN THE EVENT THAT A HOME CLUB NOTIFIES THE OPPOSITION THAT THE GROUND IS UNSUITABLE FOR PLAY, A **HOME CLUB OFFICIAL** MUST ALSO NOTIFY THE SACA COMPETITION ADMINISTRATOR(S) VIA EMAIL AT [COMPETITIONS@SACA.COM.AU](mailto:COMPETITIONS@SACA.COM.AU) BY **6:00PM ON THE DAY PRIOR TO THE MATCH**. THE SACA COMPETITION ADMINISTRATOR(S) WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING ANY SACA UMPIRES WHERE RELEVANT.

WHERE NO CANCELLATION HAS OCCURRED BY 6:00PM ON THE DAY PRIOR TO THE MATCH, BOTH TEAMS AND PLAYERS **MUST** ATTEND THE GROUND READY FOR THE MATCH TO BEGIN AS SCHEDULED. IF THE DECISION IS MADE TO CANCEL THE MATCH ONCE THE INSPECTION HAS OCCURRED, THE **HOME CLUB** WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETING THE FIXTURE OUTCOME OF **CANCELLED** IN PLAYHQ.
